Treasurer's Report:

- Last year's closing report ready for Chairs' and Principal's signature
- Closing balance as of June 30, 2023 was \$2,915 to be carried forward to September 2023

- Actual expenditures for 2022-23 were \$5,207.03
- Council to discuss future spending to be included in the budget for 2023-24

Teacher's Report:

- Teachers have requested \$100/classroom teacher (11 classrooms)
 - Council voted to provide \$1,100
 - o Teachers must provide receipts and spend by March 1, 2024

Chair's Report:

- Breakfast with Santa
 - o Pancake supplies donated by Sunnyside Grill
 - Plan to send a thank you card for their donation
 - o Sold 121 packages in 2023 (vs 139 in 2022)
- Funds Raised To Date
 - o Dough Raiser \$260
 - o Greenery Fundraiser \$279.01
 - Flip Give Fundraiser \$690.15 (from last year)
- Fundraising Plans
 - o Plan to do another dough raiser in January 2024
 - o Will look into Krispy Creme for 2024
- Jingle Bell Dance-a-Thon Fundraiser
 - o Providing two prizes to the school movie pass and Toys R Us gift card

Principal's Report:

- 2024-25 Planned Spending
 - Items for Council to consider for current year and future year planned spending were discussed
 - o 2nd basketball net for intermediate yard
 - Council asked if they can contribute towards \$3,679 cost
 - Grad composites cost \$25 per composite for 27 grade 8 students
 - Council voted to contribute \$500
 - Awards wall
 - Need awards/plagues to put on the wall cost to be determined
 - Other future needs
 - School tech is outdated and will no longer be supported, including ipads (approx. \$467.84 x 10 ipads), chrome books (approx. \$469.98 x 20 chrome books), smart boards (approx. \$3K each)
 - Gym mats needed to go against wall to protect students from injury (approx. \$10K)
 - The School confirmed that funds from the Jingle Bell Dance-a-Thon would go towards some of these costs and other school needs
 - Council discussed that upcoming spring fundraisers can go towards specific fundraising items

- Council voted that the spring fundraising can be directed towards the purchase of a 2nd basketball net for the intermediate yard
- o The School discussed other grants that have been obtained or are being explored
 - The outdoor grant has been reduced from \$4K to \$2K this year, and will be directed towards the Grade 8 grad trip and sports team uniform costs
 - Peel Healthy Living grant will be used towards painting the school grounds
 - Looking into a possible grant from Peel to support the purchase of two new bike racks for the school
- School Staff
 - New 2023-24 school staff were discussed
- Breakfast with Santa
 - o Permit is ready
- Basketball Net
 - New net for intermediate yard ordered
 - Scheduled to be installed soon
- Grade 8 Trip
 - o Meeting to discuss trip to Camp Muskoka held
 - o Positive feedback received
- EQAO Results
 - o St. Helen 2022-23 EQAO results were presented
 - Concerns with results were discussed
- Food and Toy Drives
 - Thanksgiving food drive was successful
 - o Christmas food and toy drives will be held in December
- Sports Teams
 - School sports team successes were discussed, including the intermediate girls soccer championship and cross country team members finishing in the board's top 10
- Mental Health
 - Discussed activities being organized by the Mental Health Committee to promote mental health
 - Comfort corner on Mondays
 - Healthy eating on Tuesdays
 - Wellness Wednesdays
 - Thoughtful Thursdays (positive message)
 - Feel Good Fridays (positive body image)
- School Trips
 - Classes have participated in various trips, including Silver Creek, Clarkson Community
 Centre and public library, Downey's Farm, the Living Arts Centre, and Iona
 - o Planning trip to Camp Muskoka
- Halloween
 - o Dance and pumpkin decorating contest held in October
- Eco Team
 - Team has led various activities, including planing a butterfly garden, ban the bottle and lights out lunches

- Choir
 - o Continues to be active in the school and supporting school activities
- Masses
 - o Will be held at the school during the year
- Safe School
 - o Bullying awareness and prevention activities taking place at the school
- Christmas
