Approval of the Minutes from Last Meeting/Tonight's Agenda:

- Approval of October 10, 2024 minutes, seconded by Mrs. Tota
- Approval of agenda, seconded by Mrs. Landriault

Treasurer's Report:

- \$6,219.13 account balance
- Less \$813.59 (\$653.59 for the poinsettias and \$160.00 for the greenery)
- Net \$5,405.54
- Waiting for pizza dough fundraiser cheque, so balance will increase

- June withdrawal error was rectified in October
- X-movement will come back to the School cost \$1,186.50
 - Council needs to vote if \$500 pro-grant can go towards the cost
 - o Includes K-8 and parent engagement events
 - School asked if Council can contribute an extra \$600
 - No Council funds if Council still giving \$100 allocation/classroom
- Gr. 8 composites
 - o School to confirm if \$500 will cover all the students
- Gr. 8 medals
 - School to confirm if \$200 is enough
- Gr. 8 plaques
 - School to confirm if \$145 is enough
- Basketball net will allocate \$0 for now
- Additional amounts allocated to the budget totalling \$3,700, which includes allocations for kinder/gr. 8 grad \$400, Chocolates \$160, Play Day \$70, Breakfast with Santa \$350, Shrove Tuesday \$100, etc
- Will email the budget for Council to vote

Teachers Report:

- Preparing for Christmas concert
- Canvassed staff about opportunities for parents to volunteer for sports teams, but not needed at this time
 - Other opportunities for parents to volunteer, such as with the Eco-team, Shrove Tuesday, Play Day, etc
- \$100 allocation/classroom 11 in total
 - Council agreed that teachers must spend by Feb 7
- Indoor/outdoor equipment
 - Council discussed allocating the Nov Dough raiser funds (\$290) plus an additional
 \$100 toward the equipment
- Technology
 - Uncertain how Board will be treating tech budget, so may need to support from School budget

Chair's Report:

- Chocolate fundraiser
 - Sold 44 boxes and received \$150 in donations
 - o After the online fee, delivery charge and prizes, we raised \$1,674.99
- Spook-A-Thon
 - Budgeted to spend \$131.14, but actual spent was \$64.87
- Dominoes Dough Fundraisers
 - o Raised \$290 in November funds to go towards indoor/outdoor equipment

- Council needs to vote on doing the January event on a Tuesday or a Friday and what the funding will be used to support
- Poinsettias/Greenery fundraiser
 - Sold 35; to confirm amount raised
- Breakfast with Santa
 - Sold 47 package A and 33 package B thus far; need to get updated totals from Mrs.
 Tiberi
 - o Council is picking up supplies for the event
 - School confirmed that there is no permit on Fri, Dec 6, so Council can set up on Friday morning
- Krispy Kreme
 - o Plan for funds to go towards school jerseys

Principal's Report:

- Upcoming events:
 - School is doing well in sporting events
 - Breakfast with Santa coming up on Dec 7
 - o Gr. 6-8 going to Iona on Dec 10
 - o Advent mass and virtue assembly in December
 - Christmas spirit week has various themes each day

 - Angel tree to support families in the community

New Business:
